Your Charity Day fundraising has contributed towards our programme work in Kenya, and made a huge impact on those living in the Siaya County, where malaria rates are high.

The project aims to reduce the overall burden of malaria amongst the population of Siaya County. Your support has helped:

- Train 496 Community Health Workers across 25 Health Facilities to support communities most at risk of malaria, reaching 210,000 beneficiaries
- Ensure malaria testing and treatment kits are available to those that need them
- Encourage behaviour change amongst communities, with an increase in the use of bed nets and anti-malarial drugs
- Achieve a drop in the prevalence of malaria in the area from 38% to 27%
- Deliver the Kenyan Government's Malaria Strategic Plan by strengthening the healthcare system



In reducing the burden of malaria we can alleviate poverty, helping children to go to school and adults to earn a living. Through the project, and ongoing efforts, these communities have the chance to live healthy and productive lives.
